
Bus accessibility

Purpose of the work

One of the high-level growth options (option B – see below) suggested in the Scoping Consultation in May 2021, was to distribute growth around 'main bus routes'. Main bus routes were defined as those routes with a minimum service frequency of an hour.



Feedback to Option B was mixed, as highlighted in the <u>consultation summary</u>. Concerns over a busfocussed approach relate principally to frequency and practicality of bus services, particularly in respect of commuter travel. They also regularly refer to the changeable nature of bus service provision. However, there was general support for emphasising sustainable travel in a growth strategy, which would include bus services. This prompted further probing of bus service accessibility, especially in respect of accessibility to different types of destinations.

Whilst Option B of the Scoping consultation identified a number of *settlements* which currently benefit from 'main bus services', it did not consider which *areas* of those settlements might be

accessible to those existing services and conversely which areas might not. Furthermore, if those settlements were to expand, would any new development be potentially accessible to or from the existing bus service?

In order to consider the above issues further, the SWLP team and Warwickshire County Council Sustainable Travel team jointly commissioned ITP to examine bus accessibility across South Warwickshire. It was specified that the information should be presented in a map format along similar lines to the example in the National Model Design Code (p9, Figure 5).

How the maps were produced

In the inception of the work, the focus was placed on identifying the types of destinations that may be accessed by bus. The following were individually considered for this purpose, and are represented on the maps:

- Major towns (centres) defined as locations for major retail and leisure
- Major and minor towns centres includes smaller towns for day-to-day shopping and service needs
- Employment centres
- Hospitals
- GPs, dentists and pharmacies
- Secondary Schools and colleges (it was considered less likely that primary school students would travel by bus)

The list of locations used in the modelling to produce the maps for each of the above is included in Appendix 1. This includes locations outside the boundary of South Warwickshire, in acknowledgement that these may be closest to, and serve elements of communities across the plan area.

The bus accessibility in respect of all the above categories was plotted twice:

- 1) Existing bus routes i.e. bus routes as they were operating at the time the modelling was undertaken.
- 2) Existing bus route plus funded improvements which will be coming onstream in the foreseeable future i.e. this added in planned extensions or increased frequencies of services which are known to be forthcoming. For example, these may be included in a signed S106 agreement.

The result is two sets of 6 maps:

- One map for each of the 6 destination categories identified above for existing bus services at the point the modelling was undertaken (March/April 2022)
- One map for each of the 6 destination categories identified above for existing and known (funded) future improvements to the existing services.

How the maps are being used and what they tell us

The bus accessibility maps have been considered at a high level in the testing Option B from the Scoping Consultation and the evolution of the spatial options for the Issues and Options consultation. They are likely to be further utilised throughout the plan making process.

Each of the maps follows a similar trend, with key corridors of accessibility broadly evident across the set. For example, the major urban towns (Kenilworth, Leamington Spa, Stratford, Warwick and Whitnash) appear to have the best accessibility to bus services generally across all categories, with some smaller towns also appearing to have higher levels of accessibility (e.g. Alcester, Henley-in-Arden, and Southam). There are also clear recurring corridors, such as north-south from Coventry to Leamington Spa via Kenilworth; through South Warwickshire between Redditch and Evesham, via Alcester, and to a slightly lesser degree between Stratford and Shipston-on-Stour.

Conversely, the 'white' areas of the map, untouched by any of the accessibility isochrones are largely inaccessible to frequent bus services.

These maps will remain a point of reference and evidence throughout the evolution of spatial options for the SWLP, and potentially in the evolution of any preferred option in the future. At the time of writing, it is clear that if bus services are to be a consideration in spatial options, there is a potential choice between locating growth close to existing provision (i.e. within areas in or very close to, the warmest colours on the maps), or seeking to site sufficient growth in an area currently poorly served/not served by buses, in order to attempt to generate services.

It is acknowledged however that patronage of bus services has been impacted by the Covid 19 pandemic, and the ongoing impact of this and other factors affecting bus use will need to be considered throughout the plan making process.


Accessibility to Major towns in the South Warwickshire region by public transport, weekday 7am-9am
